

To join in the celebrations at Paddle for Life...

Step #1

Each team will have a captain. The captain must register the team. He or she will be responsible for registration, both online and on-site; ensure that all team members understand the safety requirements for the day and respect them, and communicate with the organizing committee.

- ✓ Complete the registration form found at paddleforlife.ca

To register the team, the captain must provide:

- Team name
 - All team member's contact information (phone, mailing and email address) and age
 - Signature of each team member verifying that they read and understood the waiver
- ✓ Send the completed registration form via Email to info@paddleforlife.ca using the subject heading "I want to participate"
 - ✓ *Every team MUST register and pay fees before June 1st, 2010.*

Step #2

Once registered, you will receive a confirmation letter from the organizing committee providing your team with a team number as well as a pledge form for each member of your team should they wish to collect donations.

Step #3

As part of the registration process, each team must pay a registration fee which is a minimum of \$500 for a team of 6 or \$1500 for a corporate team. Team members may use the pledge form to collect donations or they may direct individuals to the Paddle for Life web page (paddleforlife.ca) to donate on line. Teams amassing the greatest amount in donations will be recognized during the closing ceremony. The registration fee must be paid by June 1, 2009.

Refund Policy

Registration closes June 1st, 2009. After that date, teams will be accepted only if places remain available. Registration is valid only with payment of the total amount for the team. In the event of cancellation, a fee of 25% will be charged. Registration fees will not be reimbursed.

Relay

The rotation or relay pattern is left to your discretion. One number only is assigned to each team and only one craft at a time per team is admitted on the course.
